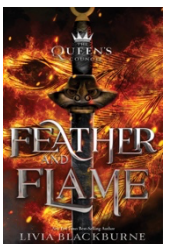

Disney's Mulan has to grapple with palace intrigue, hidden enemies, and invading armies when she unexpectedly becomes Empress of China.

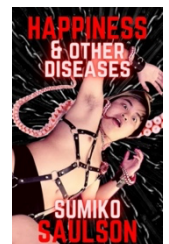

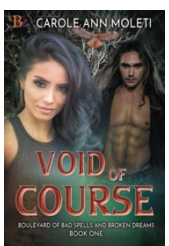

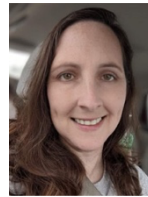
